Daily Plan -

Day 1

Welcome to Seattle

Arrive in Seattle and pick up your rental car. Make time this afternoon to visit the Space Needle or the superb Explore Music Project before enjoying dinner and coffee at one of Seattle's excellent restaurants.

Day 2

Boeing Factory

See where (and how) airplanes are built on this tour of the Boeing factory near Seattle. Tour the massive Boeing assembly plant, the world's largest building by volume, and see signature Boeing planes in production. Explore the interactive exhibits and displays in the 28,000-square-foot Aviation Center Gallery and visit the educational Future of Flight Aviation Center museum.

Day 3

Mt. Rainier National Park - Portland

Depart Seattle today en route to Mt. Rainier National Park, one of the outstanding scenic wonders of the Northwest. Cross the Columbia River for a stop at Mt. St. Helens that will reveal the devastation created by the 1980 eruption of this active volcano. Then continue to arrive in Portland in the evening.

Day 4

Columbian River Gorge - Multnomah Falls - MT Hood - Oregon City

Depart Portland pass by The Columbia River Gorge which is a canyon of the Columbia River in the Pacific Northwest of the United States. Photo stop at Multnomah Falls, formed by the cataclysmic Missoula Floods beginning 15,000 years ago and fed mainly by underground springs, Multnomah Falls drops 635 feet in two major tiers down basalt cliffs. Afterwards proceed to visit MT Hood also known as Wy'east, is an active stratovolcano in the Cascade Range and is a member of the Cascade Volcanic Arc.

Day 5

Christopher Bridge Wine Tour - McLoughlin Promenade

Christopher Bridge Wines, located at Satori Springs Estate Vineyard, offers a wine tasting experience in a Northwest timberframe tasting room, with views of the Willamette Valley. They specialize in estate-grown wines, including Pinot Noir, Pinot Gris, and other European varieties like Ehrenfelser, Kerner, and Zweigelt

Day 6

Warm Springs - Umpqua National Forest - Roseburg

Umpqua Hot Springs, also known as Toketee Hot Springs, is located in Umpqua National Forest, near Roseburg, Oregon. It's accessible via a short, but steep, hike from the trailhead parking area off Forest Service Road 3401. The hot springs feature several cascading pools, including one with a wooden shelter, and are known for being some of the warmest in the state.

Day 7

Redwood National Park - Mendocino

Pass former Russian fishing settlements as you continue your drive South today. The giant redwoods are protected in state and national parks that collectively are a World Heritage site.

Day 8

San Francisco

Follow the coastline of California north to the village of Mendocino. The town of Mendocino is a Historic Preservation District on the National Register of Historic Places with a superb coastal setting and is the perfect place to linger before continuing South to San Francisco. There will be time to explore the city this evening.

Day 9

Golden Gate Bridge - Fisherman's Wharf - Alcatraz Island

Enjoy a wonderful day touring the city. See places like Union Square, Golden Gate Bridge, and Fisherman's Wharf, where you can take a short boat trip to tour infamous Alcatraz Island.

Day 10

Monterey - Carmel

Today's drive takes you down the California coast to Monterey. Stroll along Fisherman's Wharf and Cannery Row before continuing along the stunning landscape of the 17-Mile Drive en route to the village of Carmel.

Day 11

Big Sur - St Luis Obispo - Solvang

A road trip from Big Sur to Solvang via San Luis Obispo involves scenic coastal driving, exploring charming towns, and enjoying California's wine country.

Day 12

Santa Barbara - Malibu - Santa Monica

Santa Barbara, Malibu, and Santa Monica are three distinct coastal cities in Southern California, each with its own unique character and attractions. They are often visited as part of a Pacific Coast Highway road trip, with Santa Monica being the southernmost and Santa Barbara the northernmost.

Day 13

Universal Studios

Universal Studios Hollywood is a film studio and theme park located in Universal City, California, near Hollywood, Los Angeles. It is one of the oldest and most famous Hollywood film studios still in use. Its official marketing headline is "The Entertainment Capital of LA"

Day 14

Explore LA City

Los Angeles is a sprawling Southern California city and the center of the nation's film and television industry. Near its iconic Hollywood sign, studios such as Paramount Pictures, Universal and Warner Brothers offer behind-the-scenes tours. On Hollywood Boulevard, TCL Chinese Theatre displays celebrities' hand- and footprints.
